



Department of Veterans Affairs Benefits Delivery at Discharge Program

The Beaufort County Veterans Affairs Office will hold multiple clinics aboard the Tri-Command for any service member that falls within that window.

Clinic dates are:

- May 10-0900-1500 NSF Beaufort Auditorium
- June 11-0900-1600 MCRD Parris Island Four Winds Club
- June 12-0900-1600 MCAS Beaufort, Bldg 807, Classroom 24

Please have the Service member request an electronic copy of their STR from their branch clinic. Please have them bring:

•Electronic STR and a completed Separation Health Assessment

•If married, bring the marriage certificate and spouse's SSN.

•If they have dependent children, please bring birth certificates and SSNs.



Who is eligible:

- Active-Duty service members
- Have a known separation date within 91-180 days.
- Available to go to VA exams for 45 days from the submission date.

Who is not eligible:

- Terminally ill.
- Awaiting discharge while being treated at VA hospital/military treatment facility.
- Awaiting Character of Discharge.
- Cannot go to VA exam 45 days after claim is submitted.
