Jack Klimp - Final Review of Report to Governor

Bill Bethea – Legislative Strategy

Compacts are becoming a way to reduce the long wait for military spouses trying to get licensure after a move. We have bills in the Senate now dealing with compacts. We're also working with LLR (Labor, Licensing and Regulation) to allow licenses from other states.

The Task Force will work with the State Chamber to try again to pass the military retirement exemption.

The motion was made and approved to submit the report to the Governor.
