MCEC is grateful to remain a trusted partner of the the Departments of Military and Veteran Affairs, and Education in South Carolina. These funds will positively impact areas of concern for military and veteran-connected children affected by mobility, transitions, and family separation. MCEC's programs provide education, professional development, and services to educators, parents, and support to our military-connected children. The team in South Carolina, consisting of a State Coordinator and Community Coordinators, will continue to deliver a high level of support to the miliary community and those that work with them. The State Coordinator works closely with the Department of Military and Veteran Affairs to determine the areas of critical need in the state and will develop execution plans with community coordinators to ensure a wide distribution of service across active duty, National Guard, Reserve, and veteran populations. MCEC will continue to plan and execute 360 Summits, which feature most of the elements needed for districts to fulfill the Purple Star School designation requirements. Expense types include local/regional travel, staff resources, training materials, program marketing collateral, and South Carolina-impacting staff compensation.
